1. You may work with **one** other person or individually.
2. Your assignment is to create a poster for the movie version of MEG.
3. Your poster needs to contain a
 - Large central image
 - An eye-catching font for the title and legible fonts for all other info
 - A quote (either from the book or an advertising line. “A long time ago, in a galaxy far, far away . . .” or “Just when you thought it was safe to go back into the water” were two from *Star Wars* and *Jaws 2*.)
 - Names of “stars” as characters, directors, etc. See the ads in the *Dallas Morning News* for ideas.
 - The film’s rating—PG-13 or R. Do you think the excessive violence merits an R? Be ready to explain.
 - Phrases from movie reviewers
4. We will work in class on Monday-Wednesday and you will use colored pencils/markers and butcher paper (we’ll provide these) to create your final design. You should work on Monday to experiment with ideas on typing paper and then spend Tuesday and Wednesday working on the final product.
5. You can use our computer to print up text for your poster (which you will then cut and paste) or, if you want color, you can print up at home and bring the text to school.
